## **Rules and Regulations**

- Charge is \$50 per child attending (\$25 for Chip & Putt, maximum of \$75 per family).
- Participants must be children of *family golf* members.
- Children 5 to 17 years of age are eligible. If his/her (18<sup>th</sup>) birthday takes place after the first day of Junior Golf, he/she may continue to play for the remainder of the season.
- The golf shop reserves the right to place juniors in the proper category.
- Juniors must be 5 years old as of June 30th to participate in *Chip and Putt*.
- Juniors must be 7 years old as of June 30th to participate in all other categories.
- 18 hole juniors will be required to maintain a GHIN handicap. Also, the junior golf committee encourages 9 hole juniors who play on a regular basis to get a handicap. There is no charge for the handicap.
- All juniors must turn in their score cards immediately upon completion of play. The Junior Golf Committee will see that the scores are tabulated correctly and will post all scores on the score sheets.
- 2, 4 and 6 hole groups must be accompanied by an adult. Parents must volunteer their time at least twice during the season.
- All juniors must abide by the dress code as stated in the ERCC rulebook.
- Proper conduct must be maintained in the clinics and on the course.

The Golf Shop is offering an additional option for Junior Golf this season. The **"Wednesday Program"** will consist of five clinics plus one playing lesson. The program is for junior's ages 5 to 17 years old. The clinics will be held on Wednesday afternoons from 2:00 – 3:00.

This program is available to **all memberships** including children or grandchildren of golf members as well as children and grandchildren of non-golf members.

- Is separate from the Tuesday junior program and will be administered by the Golf Professional staff.
- Schedule: Wednesdays (July 1, 8, 15, (no clinic on 22<sup>nd</sup>) 29, Aug. 5 & 12)
- Instruction is from 2:00 –3:00, except the playing lesson on August 12th will from 2:00 – 4:30
- Costs \$100.00 per child.
